- **Carsey Institute Study Finds Higher Percentage of Rural Children Live in Poverty than Five Years Ago**

A study by the Carsey Institute, based on just released U.S. Census Bureau data, found that in forty-one states, a higher percentage of rural children live in poverty than did in 2000. While the national poverty level was relatively stagnant compared to last year's poverty level, the situation is clearly becoming worse for rural kids.
