# • Carsey Institute Releases Report on Predatory Lending in Rural America

A new brief by the Carsey Institute at the University of New Hampshire examines predatory mortgage loans and the harmful impact they have on rural homeowners and their communities. The report finds that minorities and low-income people are more likely to fall victim to highercost loans. The brief includes recommendations for policy changes at the state and federal levels, as well as advice on identifying and avoiding predatory loans. # Pew Hispanic Center Releases The Changing Landscape of American Public Education: New Students, New Schools

The Changing Landscape of American Public Education: New Students, New Schools, a new report from the Pew Hispanic Center, examines the intersection of two trends that have transformed the landscape of American public education in recent years: a rapid increase in enrollment and a surge in opening new schools. The report describes the racial and ethnic components of enrollment growth at various levels of the K-12 system, the composition of enrollment in newly-opened schools as well as older schools still in operation, and the impact of the rapid growth in Hispanic enrollment.
