

Indiana has been selected for participation in the newest phase of "Stronger Economies Together" (SET) initiated by the USDA Rural Development National Office Community & Economic Development team. The SET Program will accept applications from multi-county regions in Indiana or overlapping in neighboring states and will select 4 applicants for final consideration by National Office. Two applicants will be chosen to receive training and technical assistance to help establish strategic planning for their multi-county regions.

The main challenge is disseminating the program and application information in an efficient and effective manner to yield the most high-quality applicants possible within a short deadline time frame.
