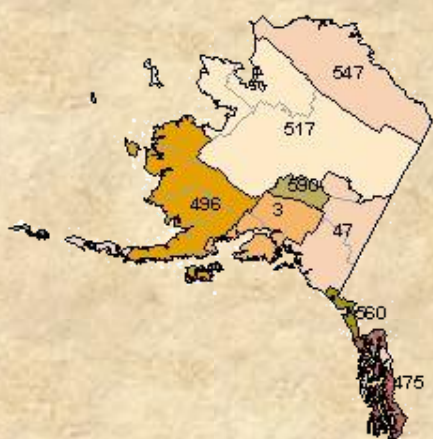
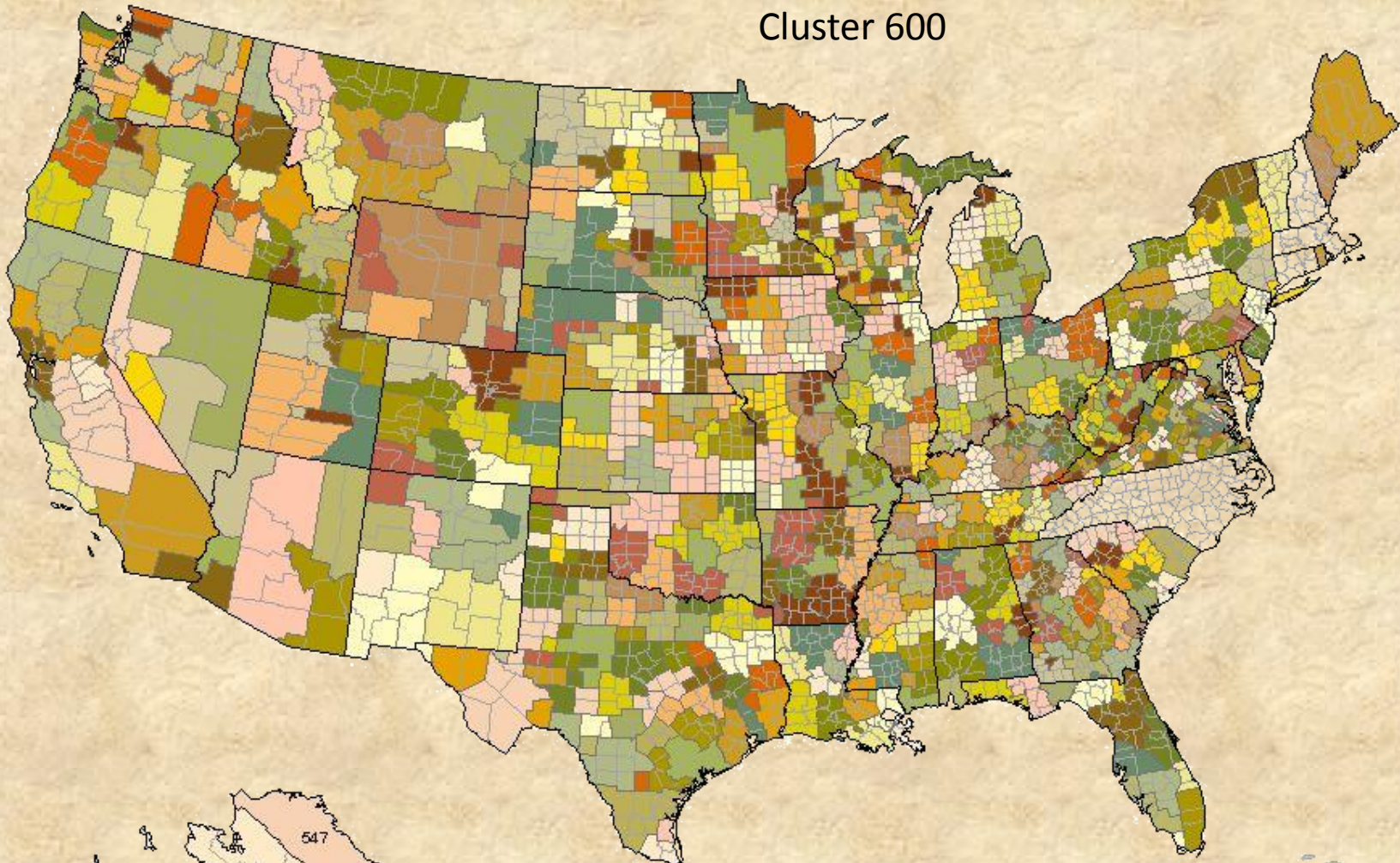
Summary

- Based on county level commuting data from U.S. Census Bureau Local Employment Dynamics Project (LED)
- LED is a cooperative relationship between Census Bureau and States
- Not all states participate; hence we have only 46 states from which regions can be calculated

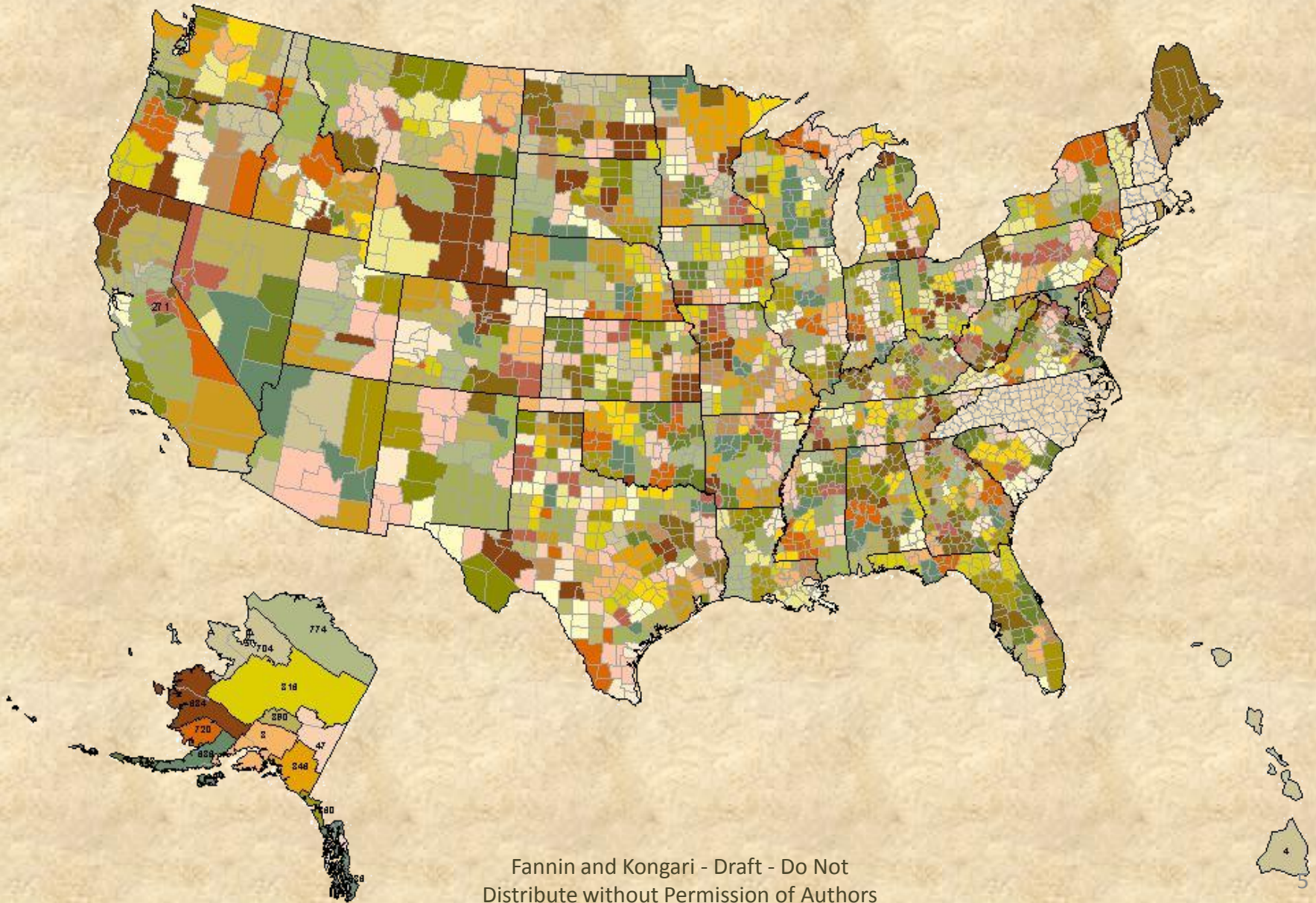
Summary

- We generated from the original 3,000 remaining counties for the 46 states analyzed to cluster maps of with 600 and 900 regions represent in the following maps.
