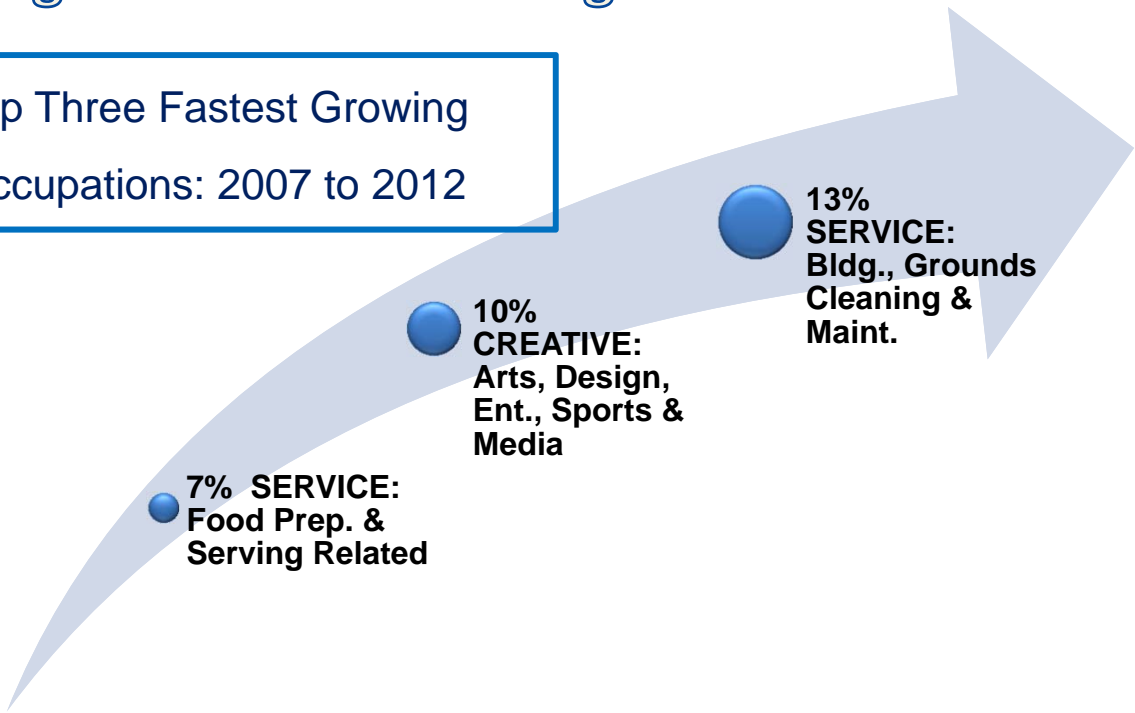
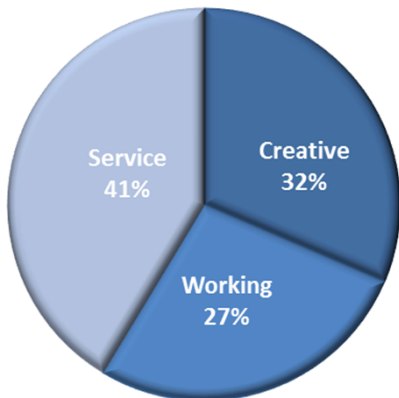

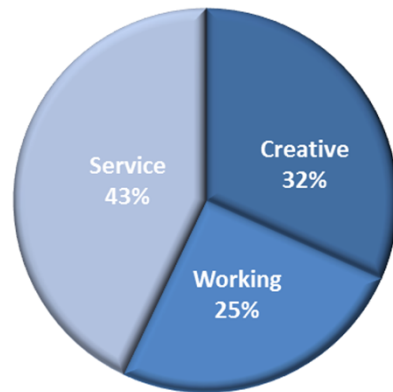
Top Three Fastest Growing Occupations: 2007 to 2012
