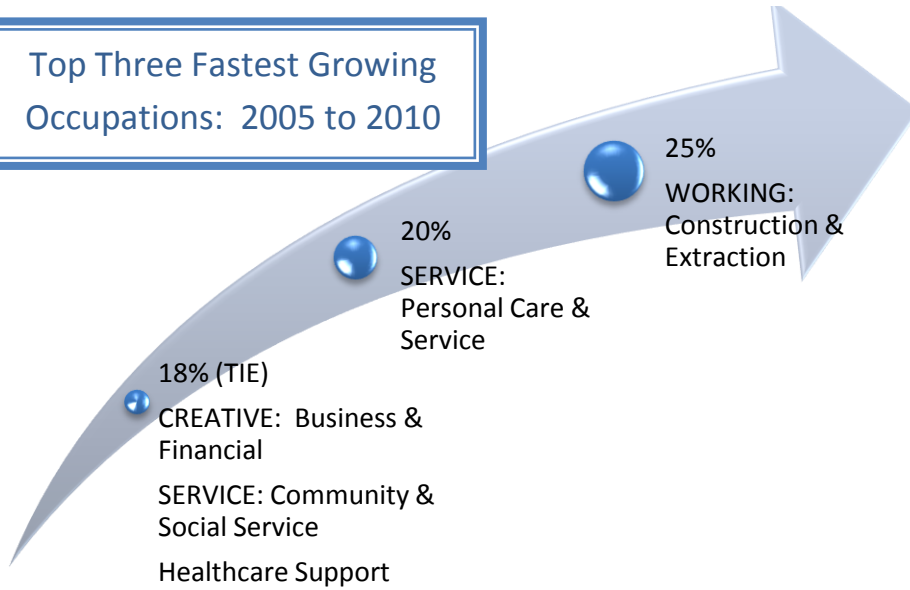
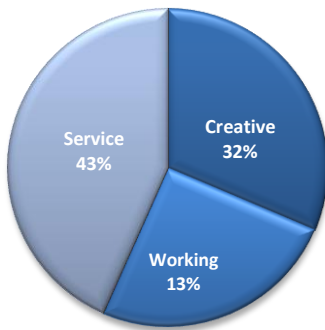

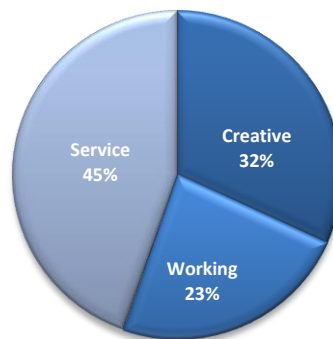
Top Three Fastest Growing
