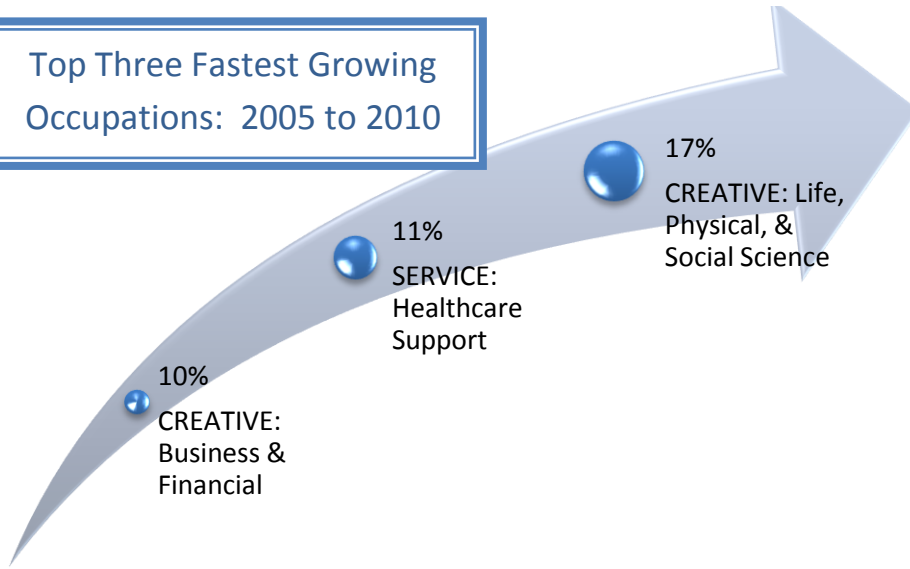
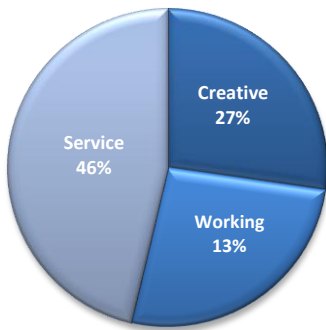


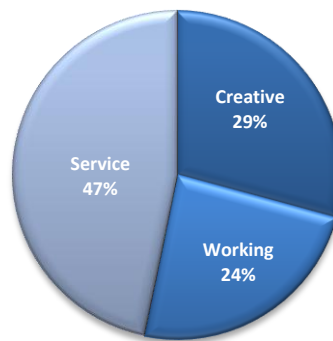
Top Three Fastest Growing Occupations: 2005 to 2010
