

Examples of How EDA Districts Have Linked with SET for Success

North Carolina Foothills is using SET to develop its first CEDS plan to become an Economic Development District.

Colorado Region 10 used SET to update its CEDS plan. They had not updated in about 10 years and were about to lose funding.

North Carolina Kerr Tar is using SET to update its CEDS plan.



Virginia Mount Rogers Region is using SET to put focused attention and plans on a cluster identified previously in its CEDS plan.

Southwest Georgia Region used SET to shore up support for their planning effort, leveraging SET resources for the planning efforts.

While not exhaustive possibilities, these examples showcase how SET can help EDA:

- Organize, plan and prepare new EDA region
- Provide support for updating CEDS in existing regions
- Re-energize faltering regions
- Move high level priorities into actionable plans from existing CEDS
